Teen Action & Support Center

TEEN THRIVE: TEEN THRIVE provides a hub for teens with housing insecurity and/or homelessness to be connected to needed physical and emotional resources, housing assistance, clothing, school supplies, mentorship and case management. The program will empower them to choose a path of healthy choices for a successful life.

Youth Bridge

The Zion Project: The Zion Project centralizes three residential homes to better equip homeless youth with the life skills to transition from homelessness/poverty to financial stability. The program builds a pathway to self-sufficiency through: permanent connections, education and employment, social/emotional well-being and stable environments and financial stability/literacy.
