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WHAT?

Dolly Parton's Imagination Library is a program that provides free books to children. All children under the age of 5 are eligible to receive a book by mail, without any cost to the family, until they reach their fifth birthday.

This program will provide children with their own library of books and equip families to support reading at home. Each child will be better prepared for school and ready to learn in kindergarten!

The first book in the program will be the classic children's book, *The Little Engine That Could*, which is a favorite book of singer Dolly Parton. The best part of this program is that this is a free gift for your child! Register your child today to receive a free book by mail each month!

WHO?

Children under the age of 5 living in Benton, Madison or Washington Counties in Arkansas.

HOW?

Complete and return the registration form, including the signature of an authorized parent or guardian.

WHEN?

When your registration form has been received, a book will begin arriving by mail at your home once you have been approved and will continue until your child turns five or you move out of the coverage area.

Is your child visually impaired or blind with an interest in reading? Are you visually impaired or blind and the parent or guardian of a child under five years of age?

If you answered yes to either question, apply now for the Braille Tales Print/Braille Book Program! Books are limited and enrollment is on a first come/first served basis. To enroll your child in the Braille Tales Print/Braille Book Program please email dpil@unitedwaynwa.org.

By enrolling in the Braille Tales Print/Braille Book Program, participating families receive six free print/braille books each year. Audio files of Imagination Library books are also available as free downloads. To be eligible for the program, you or your child must meet the definition of blindness. This program is made possible through a partnership with the American Printing House for the Blind and Penguin Group USA.
